2015 SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

Summer School is **not offered at Cardinal O'Hara High School**. This policy is to help ensure students are performing to their maximum potential throughout the school year. Cardinal O'Hara students who received a final course grade(s) below a 65% in their *core* academic classes are required to attend an approved summer school program. Regular Education students who received a Regents Examination grade below a 65% are recommended to attend a review course for the *required* Regents Exam(s) in August (if offered).

Important Note:

** School Districts require written approval from Cardinal O'Hara High School indicating exam/course needed and score earned when registering for summer school. If a student fails a course or a Regents exam that is offered in summer school, a letter will be sent home and we will attempt to make phone contact.*

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY IN THE EVENT OF FAILURE, TO CONTACT YOUR HOME SCHOOL DISTRICT AND PURSUE THE SUMMER SCHOOL REQUIREMENT.
